AGENDA DISCUSSION:

Deanery 6 On-going Matters

The Faith Formation committee is meeting to plan and discuss next year's events and they will include the Called & Gifted follow-through in our parishes. Fr. John asks our different parishes to send representatives to join the committee. Fr. Robert Broccato will look for a couple of representatives from CTK. Fr. Eddie said Sr. Patricia Galli will be the representative from MHT.

The plans for the Cristo Rey High School project have not been finalized.

Social Justice Project-Just Faith is an 8-wk program according to Fr. John.

According to Willy Agbayani, Pat Waite is willing to start as Coop Administrator as soon as possible. He will be invited to attend the June Deanery meeting.

Ruben Solorio reported that 3 Youth Leadership Trainings (YLT) have been cancelled for lack of participants. Ruben asked the Pastors to discern on who to send to training. Linda Rokita mentioned that DSJ Youth Ministry is committed to training our youth leaders and they send them to ILM Youth Training...this is putting our ADA \$ to work for us. Fr. John reminisced that in the 80's let us try to recall what was our purpose for these YLTs...then, there were no youth ministers, no funds to hire them, the existence of multi-cultural communities. Fr. Eddie Obero said Youth leaders may not be aware of these trainings. If DSJ has the resources for training our youth leaders maybe we can give up the Deanery youth training. Fr. Eddie Samaniego said what Ruben is

offering is middle management training as oppose to the DSJ training of current youth leaders. Ray Crisologo commented and asked where the youth leaders are...they should be part of the deanery meeting. Some of the youth leaders are volunteers and they are working. It was decided to call a meeting of these youth leaders/ministers and their pastors/associates with Fr. Francisco and Ruben Solorio to meet one evening before the next deanery meeting and dialogue.

Bernice Aguilera, Truancy Case Mgr. at Catholic Charities, works on the East side at Overfelt & Fisher School including some other schools. They are advocates for the youth and their work is focused on empowerment, and accountability for their actions, build support groups for at risk youth, youth in gangs who want out.
