Meeting Minutes April 23, 2004
Date: April 29, 2004

A Cooperative Meeting was held at St. Maria Goretti to finalize the plan for the Santee Mission.

The meeting was convened at 1:30 pm, a decision was reached on a new facility, on the level of financial support needed from the Cooperative parishes, lay support needed, organizing assistance and clergy support. The meeting was adjourned at 3:00 pm

The following resolutions were passed:

1. The Mission will continue under the leadership and guidance of the Sisters
2. Kennedy School was selected as the facility for worship because of its pleasant environment, smaller space and hospitality area. It offers less noise, a good location, a sound system and a cooperative staff.
3. Cooperative parishes agreed to continue providing financial support to Mission through Fiscal Year 2005 to the best of their ability. The amount from each parish will be established in the next two weeks.
4. The Mission has a shortfall of \$1,800.00 per month that will be made up by the Cooperative parish commitments.
5. Fr. Rios will continue through July with Fr. Adolph serving as his replacement
6. St. Maria Goretti staff will provide organizing assistance to the sisters to develop lay involvement and support
7. Joe will talk to Victor, a maintenance man at St. Francis who attends Santee, to invite him to be a leader at Santee Mission
8. The Sisters with help from Victor will organize a Worship Coordinator and Pastoral Community for this Ecclesial Community
